Talk with your child about your
favorite Bible stories and why
you find the Bible to be special.
Ask your child about parts they
enjoy.

Wonderground (1st-5th)

After God gave the Holy Spirit,
1000s started believing in Jesus.
Why do you think they believed?
What do you think the first
followers did together? What do
you think Jesus' friends told
people about Jesus?
